E-2020 Guidelines & Contract
Summer 2017

E2020 is an online credit recovery program that McKinley High is offering as a service to students outgoing and upcoming seniors. In order to participate in the program, this contract must be signed by parent and student. Ongoing participation in the program is dependent upon the student's weekly progress, behavior, and attendance. The following guidelines will be strictly followed.







Dates: Mon-Thurs: May 30th (Orientation) – June 22nd & June 26th – Jul 20th
Session Times: 8am-10am & 10:30am-12pm

Students needing more than one course must attend the both sessions. Students needing only one course may opt out of the second session but must attend the morning session and will still be responsible for meeting each target.

By signing this contract, I understand that students are expected to:

-  Sign in on the roster with their teacher each day.
-  Wear McKinley school uniforms & school issued ID.
-  Meet the targeted progress percentage by Thursday of each week to avoid probation or dismissal.
-  Work on one class at a time. (Students must complete one class before moving on to another).
-  Attend class each day. Only one absence is allowed. Two tardies amounts to 1 absence.
-  Take all tests in class. Tests can only be unlocked during your session with your teacher.
-  Stay focused and progress through to each target. Students will have up to three chances to pass each test. After the third chance you must move on.
-  Taking notes on each lesson is mandatory. Students may not request help from the teacher without detailed notes. Students who do not meet their progress target will not be given consideration for probation without detailed notes.
-  Progress Probation is at the discretion of the E2020 Coordinator and will be based on percent completion, the expected target for the week, behavior, and student note-taking.
-  Behavior Offense:
 - 1st Offense- Student will be sent home for the day with a probation letter, a parent must return and meet with coordinator/teacher with signed probation letter for student to return.
 - 2nd offense- Student will be dismissed from the program despite current progress.
